

# Fund the Gap Frequently Asked Questions

## Why are donations crucial?

Peace Valley Charter School provides children in the Treasure Valley access to a Public Waldorf education without charging tuition. This education costs more than what the state provides in funding, which is only 65% of what a traditional school receives. We are trying to make up a \$120,000 gap in funding.





## How are donations to Fund the Gap used?

We are an Idaho nonprofit and a 501(c)(3) and donations may be eligible for an Idaho Tax Credit. Your donation funds school expenses for the year, including our particular Waldorf classes like Strings, Eurythmy, Mandarin, and Handwork.

#### How much and how often should I give?

Peace Valley welcomes all amounts! Our requested pledge is \$400/year per child, or \$44/month per child, but many families give more or less, according to their ability. Our program gives you flexibility to donate monthly, quarterly, bi-annually, or one time by credit or debit card.





## How do I start a pledge?
